User PERSONA// You need to **communicate** who will be your users/target audience and the context chosen.

1. Imagine the user that will use or see your work. Apply the **PERSONA method** by imagining the typical user by creating her/his identity. Give that user a name, a face, personal information, likes and dislikes.

Name: XiaoLi

Age: 5 years old

Nationality: Chinese, Beijing

Languages: Chinese and bits of English

Situation: Kindergarden student raised by a single mom. XiaoLi is very active, playful, and likes to watch cartoons on her mom's phone.

Likes: Teddy bears, riding her bike, sunny days, eating sweets, eating new things, asking to her mom to buy her anything interesting, watching videos, watching cartoons, playing games, seeing friends.

Dislikes: Being ignored, being bored, not having what she wants, being in dinners with adults for too long, being on a table for too long, not being distracted, not seeing her father.

Why would XiaoLi use a phone holder? XiaoLi needs to be constantly distracted when she is not tired. Her mom got used to let her play with her phone and watch her cartoons so she is silent. When they are outside, they don't have the phone holder and need to use a glass to hold the phone. They usually use the phone holder at home.
